COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE

In normal circumstances you should not need to do anything in the event of an emergency as it will be controlled by factory personnel or the emergency service. The Police will notify you if there is a need to evacuate.

The only circumstance that would require you to take emergency action is if you can smell Ammonia. Remember Ammonia, has a strong penetrating pungent odour and in high concentrations will cause irritation and breathing difficulties. If you can smell Ammonia you should take the following actions immediately.

DURING AN EMERGENCY



Go immediately indoors.



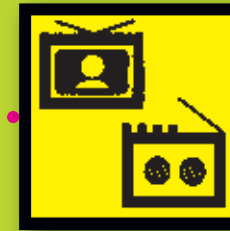
Close external doors and windows.



Switch off any air conditioners or exhaust fans.



Remain indoors until you receive instructions from the emergency services.



Tune into the radio or television and listen for instructions. The "all clear" will be announced by emergency services.



The telephone should be used for emergencies only. This ensures that the lines are free for emergency services.



AFTER AN EMERGENCY

After the "all clear" has been given, open doors and windows to restore ventilation.

Please co-operate fully with all instructions given by the emergency services.

EMERGENCY GUIDELINES → ALARMS

Our emergency alarm is either a continuous or pulsing siren. It is tested every Wednesday at 10.00am preceded by an announcement over the public address system on the site. It is also sounded during emergency exercises.

EMERGENCY GUIDELINES → SITE EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

All personnel on site are trained in what to do if the emergency siren is activated. The factory is well placed to deal with any situation through procedures and a trained emergency response team. We also work closely with the emergency services in combined exercises.
